Hair: Ballet bun *or* neatly pulled back

Attire: Leggings or tights • sports bra/form-fitted top • leotard optional

Shoes: Capezio caramel-color jazz shoes (**all jazz classes**)

Hip Hop

Hair: Ponytail or secured back

Attire: Sweatpants or leggings • Legacy T-shirt or similar loose-fit top with “hip-hop flair”

Hair: Ballet bun *or* neatly pulled back

Quick-Reference Highlights

- **Ballet:** Black leo + pink tights only; younger dancers need leather shoes without drawstrings.
- **Tap:** Lace-up full-sole taps introduced for ages 8 +; consider Jason Samuels for upper levels.
- **Jazz:** One color, one brand—caramel Capezio—studio-wide.
- **Hip Hop:** Nike AF1 energy—keep it clean, keep it white.
- **Contemporary:** No shoes, but hair still tidy.
